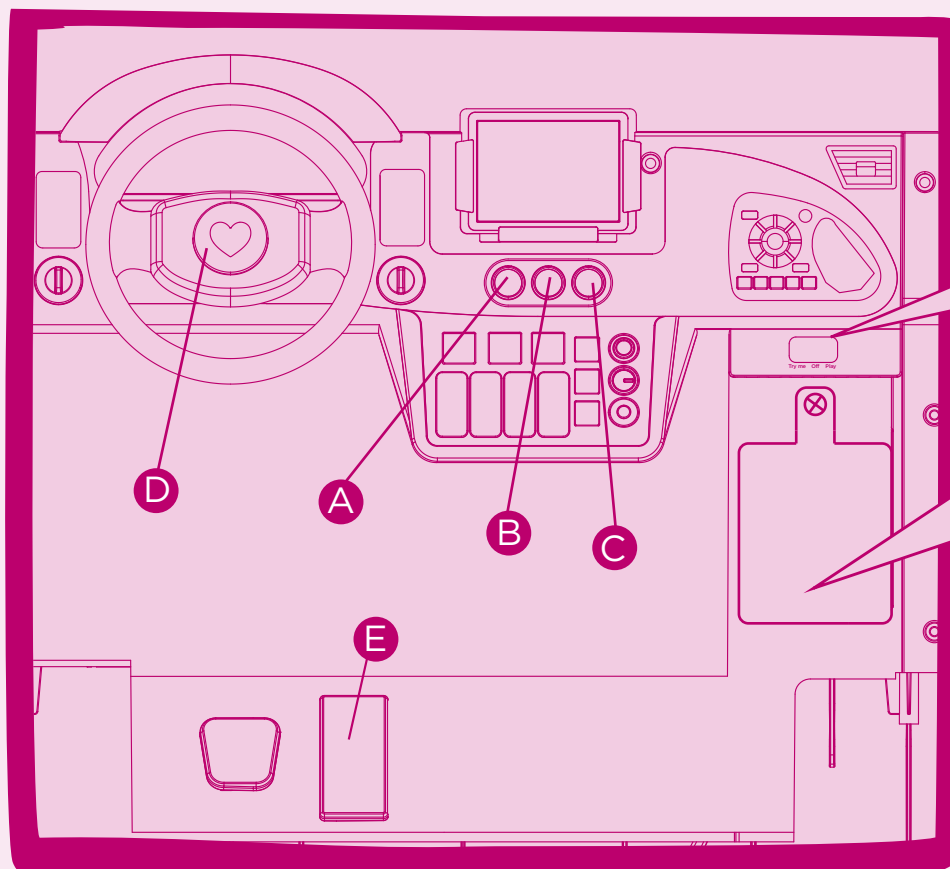

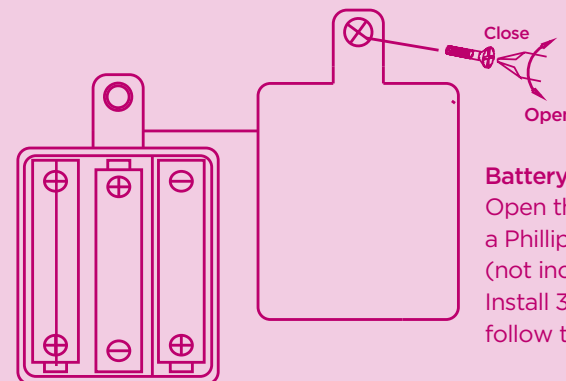

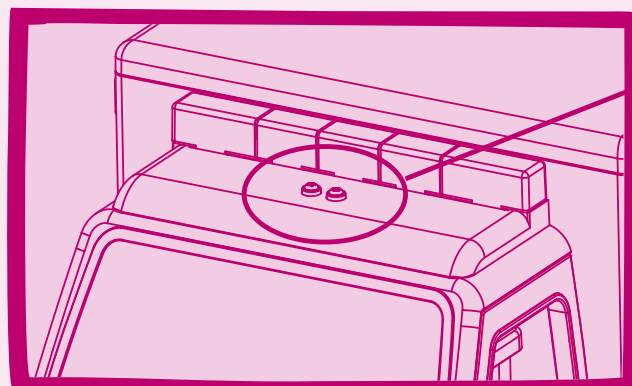
- A. Press light button to turn on headlights
